


First Quarter Commentary

International stocks, as measured by the MSCI ACWI ex USA Net Index, rallied in the first quarter alongside the broader global equity market as central banks provided dovish surprises and U.S.-China trade talks appeared to be progressing well. In this environment, the SGA International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Strategy outperformed the benchmark.

The outperformance was driven primarily by stock selection rather than sector or country allocation. From a sector perspective, Financials and Information Technology were the main source of positive selection, partially offset by weaker selection in Communication Services. Canadian software company Constellation Software was the largest contributor to positive selection in Information Technology as it declared a special dividend and improved its financial disclosures. From a country standpoint, selection was notably strong in the U.K., while South Korea was the area of weakness. In the U.K., strong fundamental performance and the lowered probability of a hard Brexit resulted in outperformance of several financial services and homebuilders in the portfolio, including 3i Group, Legal & General Group, Lloyds Bank, Persimmon, and Taylor Wimpey. In South Korea, LG Uplus was the main driver of negative selection.


The SGA Alpha Model was positive for the quarter among non-U.S. large cap equities. Within the model, the Growth category was the strongest contributor, followed by the Quality category which was modestly positive.

International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Composite includes all discretionary, investment restricted, equity only accounts whose primary investment objective is growth, and secondarily yield, and are invested in international large cap securities. The minimum account size for this composite is \$100 thousand. For comparison purposes, the composite is compared to MSCI ACWI ex USA Index (Net). The International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Composite was created June 30, 2015. Prior to December 31, 2016, the International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Composite was known as the International Large Cap Core Equity MSCI All Country World ex-U.S. Composite.
