

Near term inflation concerns led to a rise in global fixed income yields resulting in a shift in market leadership with longer duration growth stocks underperforming value. The expectations for improving global growth and measured central bank responses to promote a full economic recovery extended equity market performance in the first quarter with the MSCI ACWI ex USA Net Index returning 3.49%. In this environment, the International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity strategy outperformed the benchmark.

The SGA Alpha Model had positive performance for the quarter among non-U.S. large cap equities. Within the Model, the Valuation category was the primary driver as all SGA Valuation factors rebounded significantly after having generally poor performance for the last several years. The other three categories (Growth, Sentiment, and Quality) all had relatively neutral performance.

Stock selection was positive in Consumer Discretionary and Materials, partially offset by weak selection in Energy and Communication Services. In Materials, the economic reopening benefitted chemical producer Kumho Petrochemical as demand for synthetic rubber was strong. Mining company Anglo-American Platinum saw large price increases for its platinum metals. In Consumer Discretionary, auto parts supplier Magna International benefitted from announced partnerships with high profile electric vehicle startups. In Energy, detractors included Petroleo Brasileiro and Neste. In Communication Services, Turk Telekomunikasyon declined after the Turkish president fired the head of the Turkish central bank.

Stock selection was positive in China, South Korea, and Japan, partially offset by weak selection in the U.K., Turkey, and Finland. Positive stock selection in China was driven by Weichai Power, which rose after announcing a plan to develop hydrogen fuel cell and LNG engines. In South Korea, contributors included banks KB Financial and Hana Financial Group, while in Japan, Itochu Corp. benefitted from rising pork prices and high demand for U.S. homebuilding materials. In Turkey, the firing of the Turkish central bank head negatively impacted Turkiye Garanti Bankasi. In Finland the main detractor was previously mentioned Neste and in the U.K., negative selection came from a pullback in consumer goods company Unilever.

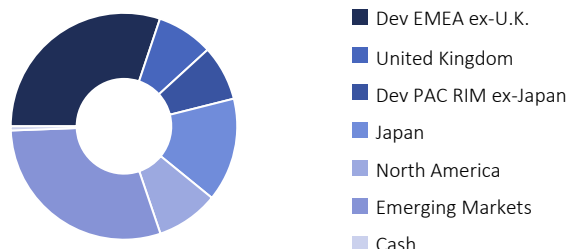

The minimum account size for this composite is \$100 thousand. For comparison purposes, the composite is compared to MSCI ACWI ex USA Net Index. The International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Composite was created June 30, 2015. Prior to December 31, 2016, the International ACWI ex-U.S. Equity Composite was known as the International Large Cap Core Equity MSCI All Country World ex-U.S. Composite.
